

Paper Supply Update

As paper manufacturers continue to shut down machines, close mills or convert paper machines to manufacture different type products throughout the US, the availability of all types of paper is challenging organizations to conduct business differently, including Western States. We have experienced longer lead times with all our paper lines, but particularly with our Western Sulphite, Roptex and Velpine paper grades.

Our paper inventory is stressed further by the fact that we are currently increasing our inventory of stock products in preparation for a busy fall/early winter. Additionally, while we may get our mill orders filled within the quoted lead time, carriers are experiencing driver shortages, causing delayed deliveries and as a result, delayed production.

How can we work together to ensure your jobs are produced on time?

- Keep an open line of communication with your sales representative and/or customer service representative regarding upcoming opportunities so they can ensure that paper is on hand when you need it.
- Be as complete and accurate with information about your paper needs. This

- Be flexible with your paper options. While all paper options are tight, we may
 have a very similar stock on the floor at the time of your order that will work just
 as well.
